#### ITEM 1

#### **Election for Cathoirleach**

#### **Adoption of Minutes**

#### ITEM 5

#### Planning - Kildare Draft County Development Plan 2017-2023

Submission on the Kildare County Development Plan 2017-2023 was circulated to Members for their consideration. Mrs. Clare Bannon outlined that there was nothing contentious in the Development plan.

Cllr. P. McEvoy proposed that the following amendment be made to the submission:

"In light of Table 12, Regional Green Infrastructure Classifications and Actions, of the RPGs, which lists 'Castletown and attendant demesnes', consideration should be given to the removal of the reference to Donaghcumper Demesne at Section 9.4.4 of the DDP (including any related policies and objectives) pending the preparation and completion of a holistic Local Area Plan for Celbridge."

This was AGREED.

#### ITEM 6

#### **Celtic Seas Partnership Presentation**

The Director introduced Dr. Travis O'Doherty, Research and Policy Officer who is working on Celtic Seas Partnership.

Dr. O'Doherty presented the Dublin Bay Strategic Management Framework as part of the Celtic Seas Partnership to the Members of the Assembly. His presentation outlined:
