Councillor Jerry Lundy's opinion adopted at the Commission for Natural Resources meeting

Councillor Jerry Lundy presented his opinion paper entitled 'Action Plan for a Maritime Strategy in the Atlantic Area - Delivering Smart, Sustainable and Inclusive Growth' at today's meeting of the Commission for Natural Resources (NAT) in the Committee of Regions (CoR), Brussels. After a short discussion the opinion was adopted unanimously by the Commission. The opinion will be presented to all Committee of Regions members at the plenary meeting taking place on the 30th November and 1st December 2017 and it is expected to be adopted at the same meeting.

Councillor Lundy is a member of Sligo County Council and the Northern and Western Regional Assembly. As a member of the Irish National Delegation to the Committee of Regions he represents the region at the European level.
