The area is constantly expanding with hundreds of new houses and estates but there have been no improvements to the local public transport routes with only one bus service the 15 & 15b operating in a very busy area. As a result of poor bus connections where you cant get south of the city or along the m50, and where it takes over an hour and a half to get into town in morning rush hour due to lack of bus lanes traffic is worsening by the month.
