Extend the metro link to include Knocklyon and Firhouse. These areas are predominantly made up of residential estates and with more houses planned to tackle the lack of houses for sale/rent in Dublin, these areas require an increase in public transport.

Already poorly served by Dublin bus, these areas need another public transport option if the residents are to reduce the use of single cars for commuting to work in the city and its surrounds. The red spine of the planned works currently terminates prematurely in Rathfarnham. Forward planning and extending it to Knocklyon and Firhouse will take a huge amount of cars off the road in the South Dublin area not only now but in years to come.
