The Director described Walter's achievements professionally, his value as a colleague and conveyed the high regard with which he held.

ITEM 1

Adoption of Minutes held on 11th December 2015

Minutes of meeting of the Eastern and Midland Regional Assembly held on the 11th December 2015 (with amendments) were proposed by Councillor Gerry Horkan and seconded by Councillor Dermot Lacey. The Minutes were **APPROVED** and **ADOPTED**.

Cllr Fitzpatrick proposed that a letter be sent to the Minister of Environment, Community and Local Government to take into consideration the emerging preferred route in light of the recent flooding issues and consider the option of a lake in the midlands.

This was AGREED.

ITEM 2

Planning

a. Draft Transport Strategy for Greater Dublin Area 2016-2035

Mr. Malachy Bradley outlined that 153 submissions were made during the consultation period and the draft document previously on consultation has been revised. Mr. Bradley stated that the Strategy submitted to the Assembly is consistent with Regional Planning Guidelines for the Greater Dublin Area. The following Councillors contributed to the discussion Clirs D. Healy, K. Dennison, D. Lacey, M. Freehill, G. Horkan, L.McCarthy, P. McEvoy and Cathaoirleach P. Vance. After the discussion it was agreed that EMRA should include with the notice the following comments:

- i. In the context of CLIP1 of the RPGs which requires "the integration of climate change considerations, based on best scientific evidence, into all policy areas relevant to them", the Assembly is concerned that the Strategy does not acknowledge the enactment of the Climate Action and Low Carbon Development Act 2015 which requires public bodies including the National Transport Authority and the Eastern and Midlands Regional Assembly to have regard to the furtherance of the national transition objective and the objective of mitigating greenhouse gas emissions, and expresses its concern at the increase in greenhouse gas emissions which is envisaged to occur over the period of the strategy.
- ii. The Authority is requested to engage with the executive of Wicklow County Council to address their concerns over the projected employment levels for the County and how they are served by transport infrastructure.

The notice was APPROVED.

b. Draft Variation No. 3 of the Meath County Development Plan 2013-2019

Mr. Malachy Bradley outlined the draft variation No. 3 of the Meath County Development Plan which addressed the economic development policies for county Meath. The following Councillors contributed to the discussion Cllrs; B. Fitzgerald, M. Murphy, T. Byrne, T. Reilly, P.J. Reilly, P. McEvoy, G. Horkan, K. Feeney, M. Cahill, D. Lacey, L. McCarthy, C. Fitzgerald, A. Duncan, D. Healy and P. Bracken. Members agreed that is be recognised that the Assembly members from Meath County Council are not supportive of this submission and the members of the Assembly recognize that all the members of Meath County Council supported the proposed draft variation as placed on display.
