Our preliminary comments are as follows (commentary is high level as we just became aware of the document):

Investment Framework – to prioritise the delivery of key enabling infrastructure and services by government and state agencies.

The delivery of key enabling services by government to support further private sector development in some very limited instances experience protracted delays due to planning & procurement processes, which has a significant impact on any associated private sector development delivery timelines to satisfy demands of the market in a timely manner.

Hence consider that policy can enable both sectors to plan & deliver concurrently, thus mitigating significant protracted delays thus managing/mitigating barriers to timely delivery.

The draft should enable some latitude & flexibility in enabling both sectors (public & private) to program delivery of services, in a complementary manner to satisfy efficient, effective delivery of places to work, live, study, visit and invest in.
