ITEM 1

Adoption of Minutes of meeting held on 13th of September 2024.

Minutes of the meeting of the Eastern and Midland Regional Assembly held on the 13th of September 2024 were proposed by ClIr D Lacey and seconded by ClIr J Fox.

The minutes were APPROVED.

ITEM 2

Presentation of the upcoming THRIVE call for proposals.

Ms Rose Power of the Southern Regional Assembly gave the members a presentation on the upcoming THRIVE call for proposals and funding opportunities.

A discussion followed with contributions from Cllr D Lacey, Cllr M Bray, Cllr R Power, Cllr G Murtagh and Ms R Power.

ITEM 3

Planning Items

i. Draft EMRA submission on the draft Longford LAP 2025-2031

Ms Anne-Marie Wood Wolfe gave the members a brief outline of the draft EMRA submission on the draft Longford LAP 2025-2031.

Two proposed amendments to the submission were requested by Cllr P Ross and Cllr M Cahill. The proposed amendments were circulated to the members prior to the meeting.

Proposed Amendment to Chapter 14

Chapter 14 of the Draft LAP should make reference to the importance of the M4 corridor to Longford town having regard to the RSES recognising the importance of maintaining, improving and protecting the strategic function of the key transport corridors in alignment with RPO 8.10 and Table 8.4 (Road Projects for the Region).

Reason: In the interest of consistency with the RSES.

Proposed Amendment to Chapter 6

Residential Sustainability and Placemaking

Chapter 6 of the Draft LAP should be enhanced by promoting an appropriate housing mix of suitable levels of private, social and affordable housing types in accordance with the Longford Key Town Requirements contained in the RSES, namely "Central to this is the requirement to provide high quality housing products that meet a variety of housing needs, including those required by employees of existing and potential industry and enterprises within the town".

Reason: In the interest of consistency with the RSES

A discussion followed with contributions from Cllr P Ross, Cllr M Cahill and Cllr G Murtagh.

The submission was **AGREED** by the members with the inclusion of the two amendments.

ITEM 4

Adoption of the Assembly 2025 budget

Ms Clare Bannon presented the Draft EMRA budget 2025. The budget increase of 9.69% for 2025 is mainly a result of increased payroll costs and consultancy costs associated with the preparation of the RSES.

A discussion followed with contributions from Cllr D Lacey, Cllr P Mc Evoy, Cllr D Heney, Mr K Kehoe and Ms C Bannon.

The 2025 budget was proposed by Cllr D Lacey and seconded by Cllr P Mc Evoy. This was **APPROVED** and **AGREED**.

Cllr D Lacey asked if any progress was made on the reform of the funding structure for regional assemblies. Ms C Bannon indicated that no further update had been received from the Department.

ITEM 5

Programme of Works – Quarter 3 update

Ms Clare Bannon provided the members with a summary of the Programme of Works for Quarter 3. A new mandate of the assembly started in July following local elections, with a new Cathaoirleach Catherine Fitzgerald and Leas Chathaoirleach David Healy elected. A number of planning submissions were made in the quarter, including to the Draft First Revision of the National Planning Framework, the draft National Transport Demand Strategy, the Draft Maynooth LAP 2025-2031, the Draft Dundalk LAP 2024-2030, and the Draft Dublin City LECP 2024-2029. Further updates were given on the preparation of a joint position paper on the Future of Cohesion Policy, and the announcement of a number of successful projects as part of the EU JTF

A discussion followed with contributions from Cllr P Mc Evoy, Cllr D Lacey, Mr O Douglas and Ms B Roe.

Cllr P McEvoy requested that future presentations on topics including the NPF, the Planning and Development Bill, or from the EPA on SEA, would be beneficial and helpful to members. Ms C Bannon indicated that the executive would try to arrange these over the coming months.
