ITEM 1

ITEM 2

Presentation by the EPA on the State of the Environment Report 2024

Mr Andy Fanning, Office of Radiation Protection and Environmental Monitoring, EPA gave the Members a presentation on the State of the Environment Report 2024. Topics discussed included a snapshot of a changing country and a presentation of each chapter of the report covering themes such as air, Environmental Noise, Climate Change, Irelands Climate Change Assessment synthesis report, Land, Land use review, Soil, Soil health, Nature, Water, the Marine Environment, Environment and Agriculture, Environment and Transport, Environment and Energy, Environment and Industry, Environment and Health and Wellbeing, Circular Economy and Waste, Environmental Policy, Implementation and Performance, and conclusions.

A discussion followed with contributions from Cllr D Lacey, Cllr M Cahill, Cllr D Healy, Cllr D Gilroy, Cllr P Mc Evoy, Cllr E Fitzpatrick, and Cllr C Fitzgerald.

ITEM 3

Presentation of the THRIVE call for proposals.

Mr E Hogan, Assistant Director of the SRA, gave the Members details on the new call for the ERDF funded THRIVE scheme available to local authorities. The presentation covered the following points: THRIVE recap - the Town Centre First Heritage Revival Scheme; Update on THRIVE Strand 1; Update on THRIVE Strand 2 Call 2 – call open on the 16th January 2025 and closing 15th April 2025; Southern, Eastern and Midland Designated Settlements, Ways you can assist, Examples shown from St Finians's Seminary Study Hall, Navan, Mallow Town Hall, Gorey Market House and Tir na nOg, Waterford City.

A discussion followed with contributions from Cllr N Gaffney, Cllr D Lacey, Cllr M Cahill, and Cllr C Fitzgerald.

ITEM 4

Programme of Works 2024 Q4 update

Ms C Bannon, gave the Members an update on the Programme of works 2024 quarter 4. Highlights included that the ORIGINN project hosted a webinar for Bioeconomy week, an URBACT National Campus was held in Balbriggan and an EUI capacity building event was held in Limerick. The EUJTF launched a number of projects including the Midlands REP Project launched by Minister E Ryan, and the EMRA Cathaoirleach C Fitzgerald. The early preventive systems audit began, and CPR annual

review meeting was held in Dublin and received positive feedback. The IREO worked to ensure the new CoR Members for 2025-2030 were agreed by the Government and organised the visit for five NWRA Chief Executives to Brussels to meet Irish MEPs, and the Irish Permanent representation. Several planning submissions were made on local area plans and the planning team delivered a training session on the functions and role of regional assemblies at the National Training Centre. Work continues in relation to the preparation of the Regional Renewable Energy Strategy and the Assembly participated in discussions with the Department of Environment, Climate and Communications and the Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage.
